1. An enthusiasm, commitment and passion to move into a career in UK nature conservation
2. Ability to use computer information technology.
3. Have a minimum of a relevant level 2 environmental based qualification or equivalent, or have about 12 months equivalent level 2 experience.
4. Good communication skills: written and verbal.
5. Interpersonal skills: Able to work with a wide range of backgrounds and ages.
6. Able to work alone and as part of a team.
7. Willingness to work to tight deadlines and out of office hours.
8. Organisational skills: Ability to prioritise and organise own individual work programmes.
9. Hold a full driving licence and willingness to travel both within and outside the region of your host organisation.
10. Have an ability to achieve 3 units of a level 3 qualification.
