Trainee Specification for Heritage Conservation Skills Trainee with Sheffield Wildlife Trust

To be successful at gaining an interview, you must illustrate clearly, how you meet both the following trainee specification and the responsibilities of the training placement you have chosen. Your interview will assess your suitability further.

1. An enthusiasm, commitment and passion to move into a career in UK nature conservation (land management, practical conservation, working as a ranger etc).
2. Have at least 9 months work relevant experience (including voluntary work) and / or have this work evidenced through an appropriate level 2 qualification / accreditation (e.g. NVQ).
3. Willingness to work outdoors on a range of sites in all weathers and ability to undertake practical works (as part of a team) on a daily basis.
4. Positive and friendly approach and ability to work with people from a wide range of backgrounds, including volunteers.
5. A full clean driving license.
6. Experience of working with tools (hand tools and / or machinery), health and safety when working with tools (inside and outdoors) and of tool repair and maintenance.
7. Ability to organise self, including a good track record of attendance and timekeeping, which are important when working as part of a team.
8. Willingness to travel both within and outside the region of your host organisation.
9. Willingness to work to tight deadlines and out of normal working hours.
10. Willingness and ability to undertake the training and development package offered as part of this placement (three units of a level 3 qualification).
